Message from Oxford and Cambridge Singing School (see attached flyer)

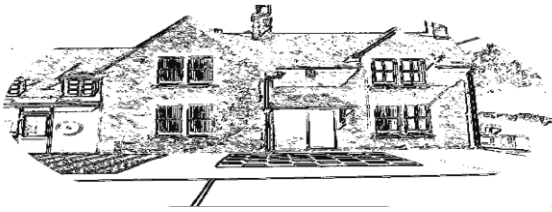
When: 20 & 21st December (Monday & Tuesday) for those aged 7-13.
